

## **Important Information for Parents and Guardians!**

**Please note the following important information for  
Tuesday, February 23, 2021:**

**Grade 11: will be coming to campus to take the ACT Plus Writing on 2/23/21.**

**Grades 9, 10, and 12: No instruction for students on 2/23/21 due to teachers administering the ACT testing.**

### **Information for Grade 11 students regarding the testing:**

- Please ***do not to schedule any appointments*** (doctor/dentist/driver's license) for test day.
- Testing will occur at **SCHOOL**. By sending your child to school for the ACT test, you acknowledge the risk of COVID-19. Students and staff will be required to follow CDC guidelines to minimize the risk, such as wearing a face mask properly at all times, physical distancing, and frequent hand washing and sanitizing.
- Your child should get a good night's rest the night before and eat breakfast on test day.
- Students shall arrive to school on February 23 by 8:10am or earlier to allow extra time for temperature check procedure.
- Students shall bring a face mask, two (2) number 2 pencils (mechanical pencils will not be allowed) with erasers and a calculator (only a four-function calculator will be provided for use); note some calculators are prohibited by ACT, please refer to the ACT Calculator Policy.
- Students must bring and provide **THEIR SCHOOL ID**. If you have lost your school ID or do not have one, please go to F-20 to get a new one before 2/22. Note: You will need to pay the \$5 ID replacement fee.
- Students are highly encouraged **NOT** bring cell phones, iPods (MP3 players), iPads (tablets), smart watches (Apple Watch), fitness tracker/watch, voice or video recording devices, laptops, textbooks, or reading material. ACT strictly prohibits these items; if they are used, your child's test score will be cancelled. Students also may not use these items during the scheduled break times as well. It is best to leave these items at home, if they do bring these items, it may be collected at the door and returned after testing.
- Students will not be able to wear any hats of any kind, sunglasses (prescription or not), or earbuds during the testing.
- Students will have a short break during the test day, and they are encouraged to bring a snack if desired. Snacks and drinks must be consumed during scheduled break time only.
- Grade 11 students will be testing all day, 8:20am – 1:30pm (approximate end time). There will **not** be an opportunity to eat lunch in the cafeteria after testing. ***Please plan to eat after school.*** It is a regular school day and attendance is mandatory.
